Registered Mail (EMS)* (The fee starts at 37-52 Baht and can go above depending on the distance.)

- 1) Contact the post office and keep the registered code/number for your reference.
- 2) Give a self-addressed envelope (17.5 x 25 cm. = A5) to the invigilator on the day of the test.
- 3) Write your **pay-in code (Ref. 1)**, which can be accessed online, on the bottom right corner of the envelope.
